Notes on My Poor Room Transcription

The time line is not to any scale, but is marked at 5-second intervals throughout. This allows the reader to match the transcript to the recording with some precision. The chief complication is with the different speeds at which passages are performed, especially with layered voices. I chose not to try to represent these variations in tempo of performance too closely using changes in font and spacing, so as to maintain an easy intelligibility. Also, of course, while this transcription is more detailed than a standard analysis of the relation between spoken word, music and sound, this transcription is not intended for audio replication. Rather, the attention is on matters of the vocal arrangements over time, which I see as central to the process of 'writing with sound' in radiophonic praxis.

In the mix process, I mixed the vocal effects dynamically at times so voices became progressively drenched in the intended effect as the effect was gain-ridden simultaneously as the dry voice was attenuated. This dynamic was reversed to 'dry up' the voice over short intervals.
